We are fortunate enough to again have our Anonymous match -- everything we spend on raffle tickets will be matched, so our contributions will be doubled. And we really need it this year because

ANNUAL APPEAL: There is great news and unfortunate news here. The GREAT news is that in 2016-17 we had both record participation rate 54.6% and we also raised a record amount in congregational donations – \$108,000. BUT, two enormous gifts that put us over our goals last year did not (and were not expected to) repeat this year, so we are well short of our \$225,000 goal. We MUST bridge this gap.

LET'S GET our participation rate up to 100%. Everybody needs to give something. We need those contributions and increased Purim contributions (with the match) so we do not end the year with a deficit.
