Dr. Reuben Vaisman-Tzachor, Professor of Forensic Psychology will speak on "The Mind of the Terrorist". In 2012 his publication, "The Book of Terrorism," based on six years as an Officer in the Israeli Navy & as a supervisor in the Israeli government's terrorism prevention operations in the western United States, describes what motivates people to engage in terrorist acts. He also assisted the Bush administration in developing a national counter-terrorism strategy. The key to our future protection depends on Dr. Vaisman-Tzachor's guide to narrowing the focus in dealing with terrorism to a scientific and laser-like profile approach that really works.
